You are warmly welcomed to attend. This time the day will be run slightly differently. The official AGM business will hopefully be completed in 30 or 45 minutes. We will hear from the Chair of the Ramblers Trustees - Lucy Robinson. After this you will have the opportunity to get involved in some workshops. I hope you will participate in these and find them valuable.

Arrival	You are welcome to arrive any time from 1.30pm . The Mole Valley Committee will be working on the preparations up until that time.
Sandwiches Tea/Coffee	On arrival you will be asked to write yourself out a NAME BADGE. Please add your name and Group to the badge and stick it to your clothing. Group Committee members will have prepared PRINTED NAME BADGES - please look for your sticker on arrival.
What will happen	The traditional agenda will commence at 2pm , <u>with the aim to finish by about 2.30</u> - this will be very strictly monitored!
Speech by Ramblers Trustee	Between 2.30 and 3pm - Lucy Robinson will be giving a speech for us after the formal AGM. The roles are: Chair, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Footpath officer, Walk Leaders, Website Managers, Holiday organisers, Social Media & Publicity Officers, Mentoring Officers & Other committee roles. There will also be a Governance Table at which Lucy Robinson will sit along with Elliot Cairnes. Members of groups are encouraged to join any workshop that interests them. This is also an opportunity to ask any questions you may have pertaining to that role. If you do not wish to actively participate in the discussion you are welcome to attend and just listen in.
