Grades - All the walk are graded as Moderate, except for the Friday morning walks which are Leisurely

- **Leisurely** walks for reasonably fit people with at least a little country walking experience. May include unsurfaced rural paths. Walking boots and warm, waterproof clothing are recommended.
- **Moderate** walks for people with country walking experience and a good level of fitness. May include some steep paths and open country, and may be at a brisk pace. Walking boots, and warm waterproof clothing essential.
- Walk gradings are provided as a general guide only. If you have any doubt about your fitness for a particular walk, please contact the leader in advance.
- Bear in mind the distance of the walk, regional differences in terrain and the possibility of bad weather, which can make a walk more difficult than planned.
- If you are unsure of your fitness level, try a short and easy walk first it is much better to find a walk a little too slow and easy than to make yourself miserable and exhausted.
- Leaders may refuse to accept participants who in their opinion are inadequately equipped or unfit.

Group AGM

The meeting on 17 November was attended by 34 members. The Annual Report was reviewed, and the current members of the committee were re-elected. They were joined by Mark Hamilton-Peach as Footpath Secretary. The Membership Secretary reported a membership of 391; an increase of 16 during the year. In Hampshire overall, membership of groups had dropped by 58, and all groups are concerned about the number of new RA members who do not opt to join a group.

The Treasurer presented the financial statement, which showed a balance increase of £538. Donations, including the one described below, had increased. The group still intends to spend some of the funds on new gates to replace stiles. The bequest fund had been reduced by providing a small subsidy to social events.

Mary Houston was appointed Webpage Editor, and Mel Thorndyke agreed to continue as Independent Examiner. The meeting closed with an expression of thanks to the committee for their work during the year.

The committee does need more support; please talk to a current committee member if you think you can help in anyway.

The meeting was followed by a very good complimentary buffet, enjoyed by all.

Walking Partnership

This is a scheme operated by Ramble Worldwide (formerly Ramblers Worldwide Holidays). When members of a Ramblers group book a holiday with them and nominates a group, the company donates to that group's funds; groups receive the donations twice a year. In the year ended 30th September 2023 Southampton Group has benefitted by £520. In October a further £350 was received covering the April to September 2023 holiday period. Thank you to Ramble Worldwide, and to our members who nominate our group when making their bookings.

Christmas walk/mulled wine/lunch
