Walk Leader Role Profile

As a walk leader you'll be joining a community of over 14,000 other volunteers helping open the way for people to enjoy walking the length and breadth of Great Britain.

You'll lead walks with your local group. You choose if that's a short city stroll, a stomp up a windswept hill, or a countryside adventure – the choice is yours. You'll connect with your group to add your walks to the local programme and in return they'll help you get the most out of this exciting and popular role.

People are what makes the Ramblers such a great community, so in this role you'll make everyone feel welcome. Whether someone is taking their first steps, or has many miles under their belt already, you'll help everyone feel at home.

What you will be doing:

- Working with the Walks Programme Coordinator to plan and lead suitable walks
- Arranging dates for walks and committing to leading the walks on those days
- Working with the Walks Programme Coordinator to advertise the walks online
- Checking and risk assessing the route before the date so that you're familiar with it
- Welcome and include everyone who comes on the walk
- Being responsible for the group during the walk, and working with your group to make sure everyone is as safe as possible
- If any incident or accident happens on the walk, report it quickly to the Ramblers

The skills you need:

- Experience of walking in your local area or community
- People person, able to lead a team with humour
- Good communication skills and able to build a relationship with all sorts of people

The training you'll undertake:

- Three online walk leadership training modules
- (Or) Let us know if you hold a Walk Leader qualification through the Mountain Training Association (Lowland Leader, Hill and Moorland Leader or Mountain Leader)
